Advocacy Continues With Legislators Back In Session

Michigan Legislators are back in session and we have hit the ground running in partnership with our statewide advocacy groups to amplify the voices of the Direct Care Workers we all know, love, and appreciate so much.

Today's statewide labor shortage (the result of low compensation and demanding work) has resulted in a critical gap in service's. Right now, many families are trying to go it alone, with many quitting their jobs to provide 24/7 care to their vulnerable family members. In other situations, we find aging parents trying to care for their adult children without any support at all. It's an impossible situation with far reaching personal, economic, and potentially life-threatening consequences.

It is past time for our legislators to fight for the livelihoods of Direct Care Workers and the life altering work they do for Michigan's most vulnerable population. It is time to stabilize the DCW profession through adequate compensation & a strong, competency-based training infrastructure to advance the profession in ways that ensure better outcomes for individuals with I/DD.




